



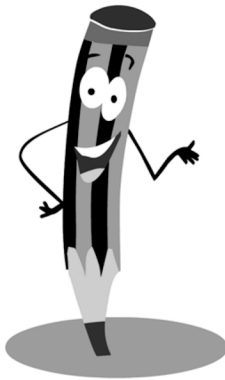
1 Write the note heads to form crotchets  and quavers .
