## Learn about am, pm and the time in the USA.

AM es la sigla de "Ante Meridiem", una frase de origen latín que se traduce al español como "Antes del mediodía". Este periodo va desde las 00:00 horas (medianoche), hasta las 11:59.

PM sería la sigla de "Post Meridiem", la frase que define el bloque de horas que van "después del mediodía". Este lapso de tiempo se refiere al bloque horario de las 12:00 hasta las 11:59 de la noche.
